Biomanufacturing Explorers:

June 3-14th (Mon through Fri, 9a-4p)

Rising 10th, 11th, or 12th graders with little to no prior exposure to biotechnology or biomanufacturing. Students curious about biotechnology are encouraged to participate.

Biomanufacturing Trailblazers:

July 8-19th (Mon through Fri, 9a-4p)

Rising 11th or 12th graders with some experience with biotechnology or advanced biology preferred. Students passionate or interested in learning more about biotechnology and biomanufacturing opportunities are encouraged to participate.

*Students may only attend one camp. Students who have participated in the Explorers camp are welcome and encouraged to apply for the Trailblazers camp.

Both camps require that the applicant has taken and passed high school level biology.

Camps will take place on the Wright State University campus. Transportation will be available from central pick-up locations for those who need it. Parking passes will be available for students who can drive themselves.

Family and friends are invited and encouraged to attend student demonstrations on the final day of the program!
