

Get the Most Out of TSMC 2021

Before the Event

- Make sure you **have a good internet connection** with enough bandwidth. Try to limit devices connected to the internet to avoid taking up too much bandwidth.
- If you can, **download Zoom** ahead of time to make joining go smoother. You can also join from your browser if you are unable to download Zoom, but some functionality may be limited.
- **Test your audio** and, if planning on joining the networking sessions, test your microphone and video too. Pro tip: try using a headset if you have one as it captures better audio than your computer's built-in microphone.
- Join the conversation on social media to connect with other attendees. Join the Facebook or LinkedIn groups or use the event hashtag #TSMC2021. Post about sessions you're looking forward to and interact with others who are posting.
